

QUEENSLAND STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

The QCC will issue a Queensland State Championship.

This Championship is the Official State Championship and is recognised by all QCC clubs.

Once gained the words QUEENSLAND STATE CHAMPION can be added to any Pedigree Paperwork for said cavy, the only recognised Abbreviations are as follows:

QLD STATE CHAMPION, QCC STATE CH., QCC CH., **QLD CH.** & QCC CHAMPION

IF Your Cavy has a Club Based Championship then the name of the club should Prefix the word Champion e.g Bayside Champion and Cairns Champion etc.

1 ELIGIBLE POINTS

1.1 Points can be claimed from a MAXIMUM of ANY 2 DIFFERENT clubs PER MONTH and DIFFERENT JUDGES

The combination of points allowed from these shows

Main Show of the club

PLUS Specialty Show¹ hosted by the MAIN show club

1.2 Group Specialty Show Points

Best of Breeds = 2 points

Best in Show + 2 points (accumulated to 4 as in Best in Group)

1.3 Gender and Age Specific Specialty Show Points

Best of Breed = 1 point

Best in Group + 1 point (accumulated to 2)

Reserve in Show + 1 point (accumulated to 3 - 3 points also awarded if RiS is Res of Breed to BiS)

Best in Show + 1 point (accumulated to 4)

1.4 Clubs hosting double shows (Such as Show A and Show B)

ONLY one set of Points will be accepted from either Show A OR Show B - NOT from both.

1.5 Once an animal has claimed the maximum points outlined above, no other points will be able to be accumulated that month from ANY other Club unless it is the ANCC National Show, All State Titles Shows, Royal Shows.

2 Point Accumulation

2.1 Points values **for ALL BREED SHOWS** are outlined below

Best of Breed = 2

Best in Group (BiG) = 2

Reserve in Show (RiS) = 1

Best in Show (BiS) = 2

2.2 Points accumulate during the show e.g's

BiG you get 4 points (BoB - 2 points + 2 points for BiG),

Reserve in Show = 5 points (BiG - 4 points + 1 for Res in Show, **5 pts also awarded if RiS is Res of Breed to BiS**)

Best in Show = 6 points (BiG - 4 points + 2 for Best in Show)

3 Championship Levels

3.1 The points will accumulate until the highest level of Grand Champion is reached

3.2 Champion = 30

Double Champion = 60

Grand Champion = 80

4 Claiming Championships

4.1 Exhibitors must apply for a Qld Championship by providing details of points to the Show secretary.

4.2 Supporting Evidence

Along with the Claim form, Exhibitors MUST supply clear original copies of the award cards for the points they are claiming, good quality PDF files of scanned originals is the preferred way to provide your evidence if e-mailing your claims.

- All points awarded at all QCC affiliated clubs shows are accepted. Points will also be counted from **major²** interstate shows, State Titles, Royal Shows and ANCC National, but not the normal (non - QLD) club shows.
- All State Titles and "Royal" Shows to attract **DOUBLE** Points, **major²** interstate shows will attract standard All Breed Club points.
- **ANCC National Cavy Show will attract TRIPLE points value, with Reserve in Groups attracting 8 points irrespective of a BoB**
- QCC State Championship is open to affiliated club members residing in Queensland only.
- A register of QCC Champion cavy will be kept and listed on the QCC website for reference

NOTES

1 **Specialty Shows are shows that exclude a specific demographic e.g. Group only shows, Boars/Sows only shows, Age group specific shows.**

2 **Major interstate shows will be defined as a Club Show with OVER 200 entries.**
